



Aftercare and Resource Coordinator New Castle County

The mission of the **Sexual Assault Response Center (SARC)** in Delaware is to respond to all forms of sexual and domestic violence through specialized crisis intervention services, comprehensive prevention education programs and advocacy for the rights of victims as survivors, family members and communities. YWCA Delaware has SARC offices in New Castle County and Sussex County.

The **Aftercare and Resource Coordinator** will provide crisis intervention, advocacy, aftercare follow up, case management and referrals for victims of sexual and domestic violence, sex trafficking and stalking. Aftercare Coordinators are responsible for the supervising interns and volunteer advocates (SARAs) to provide outreach and coverage for the office resource center, and provide service coverage for the Helpline, On Call and Supervisory shift coverage for program service. Aftercare Coordinators support training activities internally with staff and advocates and externally with community partners. Aftercare Coordinators must have a Bachelor's Degree in Human Services or related field and 1-2 (one-two) years experience in similar social or human service agency/shelter or an Associate's Degree and 2 (two) years experience working with diverse populations. Bilingual (En/Sp) skills are preferred. This position reports to the SARC Director. The Aftercare Coordinator in both counties work together as a team to provide compassionate and timely service statewide.
