The Communications Intern will be an integral part of YWCA Delaware's Development Team and will support YWCA Delaware's Media Manager. This position will run from September through December 2023. The Social Media Intern will have the opportunity to support and execute comprehensive marketing, communications, and digital media for YWCA Delaware. This includes coordinating with the Development Team to promote our online presence regarding our programs, services, events, and advocacy positions. The Communications Intern will have the opportunity to effect meaningful change, gain experience in nonprofit advocacy, and make valuable connections among community leaders. The application deadline is Tuesday, August 22, 2023.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities may include:

- Prepare engaging written, image-based, and video-based content
- Contribute content for newsletters and social media posts, including Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, Threads, Tik Tok, YouTube, and LinkedIn
- Attend departmental meetings and virtual and in-person events
- Assist with marketing efforts for events, speaking engagements and pressers
- Assist with editing short videos and podcasts
- Identify influencers (internal/external) and social media trends
- Maintain brand consistency, coordinate messages, and adhere to the highest standards for external digital communications
- Adhere to an editorial calendar to ensure content is timely, relevant, and engaging
- Demonstrate a commitment to racial and gender equity
